Line of Reasoning Infographic Posters

Today you will put your knowledge about the *parts of an argument* in to play to establish your own *line of reasoning*. As a group you will establish your own *line of reasoning* around an issue you care about. Think back to the assignment where we built weak and strong arguments for inspiration. Your *line of reasoning* must feature the following components:

- A minimum of three strong *claims* but no more than five *claims*
- *Evidence* from reputable *journalistic* sources (magazines, newspapers, journalistic websites)
- A summary of how the *evidence* supports the claim (*reasoning*) that is no more than two sentences per claim)
- A visual representation of the *connections* between claims

You will draft your argument on notebook paper and then create a poster which represents the argument in a visually stimulating *infographic*. The final product to be submitted will be a poster.
